



## Mouw Law | Parental Coordination Fees subject to Court-Approved Allocation

Judges and Attorneys to Order or Stipulate to Specific Modules

**TABLE 1 — Coordination Modules (A-C)**

*(For parents seeking support, clarity, or stabilization- One time Fee, shift to Judicial Monthly Modules below if needed after complete)*

Module A — Communication & Implementation	For parents needing structure + support, not evaluation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Two 45-minute sessions</li> <li>• Parenting plan troubleshooting</li> <li>• Communication guidance</li> <li>• Written summary of agreements</li> </ul>	\$300 per parent (\$600 total)
Module B — Pattern Scan + Coordination	Adds light Vay'Mark pattern review	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Everything in Module A</li> <li>• Review of selected communications/records</li> <li>• Identification of conflict cycles</li> <li>• Light Vay'Mark elements (inconsistency markers, pathway cues)</li> <li>• Pattern-informed recommendations</li> </ul>	\$450 per parent (\$900 total)
Module C — Full Pattern-Informed Coordination	Deep dive using Vay'Mark System™ mapping for complex dynamics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Everything in Modules A &amp; B</li> <li>• Nervous System Map™, Parental Response Grid™, or Timeline Cluster elements</li> <li>• Comprehensive stabilization plan</li> <li>• Pattern profile summary (not a court report)</li> </ul>	\$750 per parent (\$1,500 total)

Judicial A — Written Determinations & Directives	Neutral decisions for discreet disputes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Review each parent's position</li> <li>• Review documents/messages</li> <li>• Apply parenting plan</li> <li>• Written decision with rationale</li> <li>• Optional attorney notifications</li> </ul>	\$450 per decision
Judicial B — Court Summary / Judicial Report	Structured report for judges, GALs, or attorneys	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Timeline of issues</li> <li>• Communication pattern overview</li> <li>• Compliance + progress notes</li> <li>• Safety concerns (if present)</li> <li>• PC recommendations</li> </ul>	\$800 per report
Judicial C — Record Review	When parents provide records, messages, collateral	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 0–25 pages → \$150</li> <li>• 25–75 pages → \$225</li> <li>• 75–150 pages → \$375</li> <li>• 150+ pages → Custom quote</li> <li>• Written summary of findings</li> </ul>	\$225/hr or flat-fee bundles

Judicial E2 — High-Conflict Monitoring	Repeated breakdowns or boundary issues	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tracking ongoing cycles</li> <li>• Quarterly Judicial Briefing (if authorized)</li> </ul>	\$250/parent /mo

Judicial E4 — Mandatory Court Report	For significant safety events	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Court-ready exhibit packet</li> <li>• Safety plan + recommended temporary orders</li> </ul>	\$950/report
Judicial E5 — Sanction Add-On	When court authorizes sanctions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• \$150 single sanction</li> <li>• \$225 multi-issue sanction</li> <li>• \$50 revised protocol/exchange add-on</li> </ul>	\$50–\$225

**TABLE 3 — Additional Fees**

<b>Service</b>	<b>Fee</b>	<b>Notes</b>
Vay'Mark Mini-Report™	\$450	1–3 pages; clarifies patterns for court/attorneys
Travel	\$250/hour	Travel time; IRS mileage added
Courtroom / Deposition	\$300/hour (3-hour minimum)	Separate from PC modules
Preparation Time	\$250/hour	For testimony or major reports
Subpoena Record Prep	\$150/hour	File assembly + compliance
Nonpayment Notice	\$50 per notice	For weaponized nonpayment
Nonpayment Court Report	\$150–\$250	If court involvement is required

Parenting Coordination services are modular and may be limited, expanded, or reallocated by court order at any time.

The Court retains authority to review the scope, allocation, and reasonableness of services to ensure proportionality and cost containment. Mouw law will utilize the least intensive module reasonably necessary to stabilize compliance and reduce ongoing conflict.
